

How to Implement Take 5 Studies/5 Day Clubs in a Region



- The Stonecrown Field Director shares with lead volunteers the opportunity to increase Stonecrown Bible Studies and CEF 5 Day Clubs by partnering with Child Evangelism Fellowship at the local level.
- The key volunteer leaders should research their state to see how CEF is organized in their area. The website for finding CEF organization in each state: http://www.cefonline.com/component/option.com_sobi2/sobi2Task,search/Itemid,179/
- The key volunteer leaders will determine where there is sufficient leadership and Guide coverage to effectively pursue this partnership.
- Seek to appoint a Stonecrown Bible Study Liaison in each designated CEF region.

What steps does the SBS Liaison take to facilitate the local partnership with Child Evangelism Fellowship?

The approaches that have been successful are detailed below. Above all, work with the Local CEF Director to implement a plan that works in his/her region. This relationship is very important and we always want to honor their requests and serve with them with courtesy and respect. We are co-laborers together.



One Suggested Approach for the SBS Liaison:

1. Contact the Local CEF Director to meet with him or her to discuss facilitation of a partnership to expand both Take 5 Studies and 5 Day Clubs.
2. Share with SBS Guides and Hosts the opportunity to offer a Take 5 study along with a 5 Day Club. Provide contact information of those interested to the Local CEF Director.
3. Obtain a list of 5 Day Club hosts from the Local CEF Director. Call them to invite them to also host a Take 5 study in the home.
4. Schedule Take 5 Studies based on response obtained from 5 Day Club hosts.
5. Provide the CEF office with the postcard invitations to the Take 5 study. The CEF office will include that invitation with the 5 Day Club invitations and give to the host.
6. The host will pass out both invitations to those they know in their neighborhood.



Second Suggested Approach for the SBS Liaison:

1. Contact the Local CEF Director to meet with him or her to discuss facilitation of a partnership to expand both Take 5 studies and 5 day Clubs.
2. Share with SBS Guides and Hosts the opportunity to offer a Take 5 study along with a 5 Day Club. Provide contact information of those interested to the Local CEF Director.
3. Supply the Local CEF Director with Take 5 FAQs, sample Guide and Student Introductory Bible Studies, and Informational packets. This material will be used by the Local Director as he/she visits churches to promote 5 Day Clubs and Day Camps. The SBS Liaison is encouraged to be available to visit as many churches as possible with the Local CEF Director.
4. Interested women from the CEF contacts will sign up to find out more about hosting or call the SBS Liaison directly from the local contact information on the brochure.
5. Schedule Take 5 Studies based on response obtained from 5 Day Club hosts.
6. Provide the host (by mail, e-mail or hand delivery) with the postcard invitations to distribute along with the 5 Day Club invitations.

What if there is more interest for studies than available guides?

1. Praise the Lord!
2. Pray for more Guides.
3. Explain the need to the local Stonecrown Ministries Outreaches, your church, and local church Pastors.
4. Organize a Guide Training Workshop (Take 5 Study Training) for May and invite women to attend from the Stonecrown Ministries outreaches, your church, and other local churches.
