



7:14 Prayer House Network **Built through God's S-O-L-A-R Power**

Mission: Expansion of God's Kingdom through strategic and Spirit-filled prayers of God's intercessors in the powerful Name that is above all names: Jesus Christ of Nazareth.

Scripture Theme: 2 Chronicles 7:14—*"If My people, who are called by My name, will humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land."*

Strategic Goal: Every week, have one or more homes open for 1½ hours, at least one time, as a 7:14 Prayer House. During this period, anyone may join in at anytime; i.e., come and go as his or her schedule allows. Prayer requests may be submitted and prayed for during this period. The ultimate goal is to have Prayer Houses open every week throughout the nation, and continuing year after year. The inspiration for this prayer ministry comes from Stonecroft Ministries founder Helen Duff Baugh, who through her faithful prayers and trust in God was able to inspire others to pray.

Prayer House Implementation (S-O-L-A-R):

Who is a Prayer House Coordinator? Anyone called by God and who has a heart for this ministry can take the lead and initiate a 7:14 Prayer House Network.

What is S-O-L-A-R Implementation?

Seek God's will. This is the Prayer House Coordinator's first step and ongoing prayer for God's anointing for this ministry.

Organize a PH team and seek God for guidance. Form a small team of Prayer House volunteers.

Lead. Schedule Prayer Houses, advertise, invite, train, and facilitate.

- Schedule the first few Prayer Houses, starting with homes of Prayer House volunteers. Then solicit new Prayer Houses.
- Prepare flyers; advertise at Planning Team meetings, Prayer Connections, outreach events, and Stonecroft Bible Studies sessions. Contact friends, neighbors, families, and churches; send out e-mails or mailers.
- Train new Prayer House Prayer Leaders using A.C.T.S. prayer format.
- Keep Prayer House schedules updated and advertised (i.e., on community calendars or at CWC events).

A.C.T.S. prayer time. Host prepares home for 1½ Prayer House session. Prayer House Coordinator leads or assigns Prayer House Prayer Leader to lead. Prayer House Coordinator submits names of new Prayer House Prayer Leader volunteers to Stonecroft, and trains the volunteers.

Reap the harvest. Anticipated results include formation of a nationwide 7:14 Prayer House Network; decisions for Christ; a ramp for outreach luncheons, Prayer Connections, and Stonecroft Bible Studies—thus expanding CWC ministries; the enhanced prayer life of Stonecroft volunteers; and much more. The list is limitless. We serve a great God! How great is He!
